



UNIFORM LIST 2026-27

The following information comprises both essential and optional uniform items. Items marked with an * are only obtainable from the school's official suppliers, Price and Buckland. In a bid to minimise the cost of uniform, we have limited the number of compulsory branded items to three, in line with new statutory guidance from September 2026. These are shown in light green in the table and listed below:

- A choice of green jumper/blue sweatshirt/hoodie with SWGS logo
- SWGS kilt (with an alternative option of trousers or shorts)
- SWGS PE top

All other items can either be sourced from Price and Buckland or alternative shops. In line with our sustainability ethos, we run a popular second-hand uniform system:

ITEM	DETAILS
Kilt* or Trousers*	Green and navy kilt (to be worn at a length appropriate for a professional/academic environment) Tailored navy-blue trousers (or shorts in warmer weather) with the school logo
Jumper*	Green V-neck jumper with school logo or navy-blue crew neck sweatshirt/hoodie with school logo (as listed in the PE section).
Shirt*	Short-sleeved navy-blue polo shirt with school logo . <i>N.B A plain navy-blue alternative may be worn in lieu of the branded option.</i>
Coat or Jacket (Should be waterproof)	Appropriate coat No denim or inappropriate logos. Only SWGS PE sweatshirts/hoodies allowed (not team or trip hoodies/sweatshirts and no other hoodies)
Tights	Navy, black or flesh coloured – must be plain
Socks	Plain navy, black or white short or knee-length
Shoes	Black sensible plain leather/vegan leather low-heeled shoes (NOT boots, trainers, trainer look alike shoes, sandals, cloth or canvas shoes of any kind)

- Hair styles/colours must be plain, natural-coloured hair.
- Scarves and outdoor coats must not be worn in lessons or tutor time.
- All uniform and personal items brought to school (e.g. purses, school bags and mobile phones) **must be clearly marked** with name tapes or indelible ink on tape.
- Cycle helmets **are strongly recommended** for those who cycle to school.
- **Students are reminded that they must not leave their valuables unattended at any time.** Valuables can be handed into PE staff for safe keeping during PE lessons.
- All jewellery must be removed for PE for health and safety reasons
- New piercings which cannot be removed for PE need to be covered
- Headscarves - Where students wear a headscarf for religious or cultural reasons, this must be plain black, white, green or blue. No part of the face may be covered.

PE KIT LIST

ITEM	DETAILS
Essential Items:	
PE shirt*	Green & white PE game shirt with school logo
SWGS skort* or shorts	Bottle green SWGS skort or plain black loose or cycling shorts (please see photographs below)
PE sweatshirt or hoodie*	Navy blue crew neck sweatshirt/hoodie with school logo (as listed in the main uniform section)
PE bag	PE bag of strong material, marked with owner's name on the outside
PE shoes	Trainers suitable for netball and general PE
PE football boots and shin pads	Studded boots, any colour and shin pads
PE socks	Long dark green socks (e.g. football) and short white socks (all other activities)
Optional Items:	
PE leggings	Black leggings
PE tracksuit bottoms	Navy Blue or black tracksuit – useful during winter
PE base layer	Navy blue base layer top
PE Sports bag	Sports bag for trainers when muddy
Other items	All equipment can be borrowed from school for lesson and club use, if a student wishes to bring in their own equipment, e.g. a tennis racket, please ensure this is clearly named.

UNIFORM GUIDELINES

SHOES

Black sensible plain leather/vegan leather low-heeled shoes (**not** boots, trainers, trainer lookalike shoes, sandals, cloth or canvas shoes of any kind).

- No sports trainers
- No alternate colour branding
- Solid sole (no foam soles)
- No visible air bubbles
- Completely black
- Leather/vegan leather shoes only

- SWGS kilts



MAKEUP

Should students elect to wear subtle makeup, the following are not allowed:

- Coloured eye shadow
- Bold eyeliner
- Heavy mascara
- False eyelashes/lash extensions
- Lipstick/lip gloss/coloured lip balm
- Heavy contouring, blush or highlighter
- Coloured nail varnish
- Nail extensions/tips/false nails

N.B. This is not an exhaustive list but rather a guide. Students are asked to comply with the spirit of this list as well as the specific examples.

JEWELLERY

- Piercings are limited to no more than two ear piercings maximum, comprising of two pairs of small studs or ear hugging hoop earrings, in ear lobes only (no drop earrings). Ear hugging earrings should be no bigger than 1cm in diameter for health and safety reasons. No upper ear piercings are permitted.
- Students are permitted to wear one small ring and one plain necklace with the option of a small pendant to be worn under shirts/jumpers.
- Excess jewellery will be confiscated; valuable items may be collected from reception at the end of the day

PIERCINGS

- No more than two plain studs, or ear hugging earrings, in each ear lobe
- No upper ear/facial piercings, clear plastic spacers may be worn if needed
- New piercings which cannot be removed, and which do not comply with the school rules will need to be covered until they can be removed
