Some families choose to donate a regular payment each month, and some make a one-off payment and this is entirely at your discretion; any size of donation is gratefully received.

If you are a taxpayer, Gift Aid allows us to claim an extra 25p for every £1 donated. Please complete the Gift Aid declaration in full and return it by email to finance@swgs.wilts.sch.uk or by post. If only one member of the household is a taxpayer, the donation must come from their bank account for us to claim the tax refund.
